Class Mark

Your class mark is determined by three class tests (of equal weight, worth a total of 75%) and WeBWorK (elements 1–6, worth 25%). There will be new WeBWorK problems virtually every week. The class tests will be given during the second meeting of Weeks IV (elements 1, 3, 5), IX (elements 1, 3–5) and XIV (elements 1–6). Quizzes will be given frequently and their scores will be recorded, but they do not contribute officially to the class mark.

Guidelines for writing tests and examinations

Before you will be given a paper, your desk must be clear of everything but writing materials (pen/pencil, eraser, ruler), and your book bag, pencil case, cell phone, etc., must be placed in a designated corner of the classroom. It is your responsibility to make sure that you have complied with these guidelines so that you can begin on time. The use of calculators is neither needed nor permitted during quizzes, class tests and the final examination.

If you know ahead of time, we may be able to arrange an alternate schedule; if that is impossible, let me know when you will be back at college (for the same reason). Do not just show up to class after the test without having been in touch, expecting me to arrange things for you at that time.
